***Short Croquet Handicaps.** To calculate your Short Croquet Handicap (SCH) - use the conversion table below. Therefore, if A's normal AC handicap is 12, his SCH is 4.

****Bisques are calculated from Base 4.** For example, in a singles game between player A (SCH 8) and player B (SCH 6), A receives 4 bisques (8-4) and B gets 2 (6-4). Players will therefore receive the same number of bisques for each of their matches other than when they meet an opponent whose SCH is below Base 4. On these occasions, 'bisque difference' is used. Thus when C (SCH 10) plays D (SCH 1), C will receive 9 bisques.
